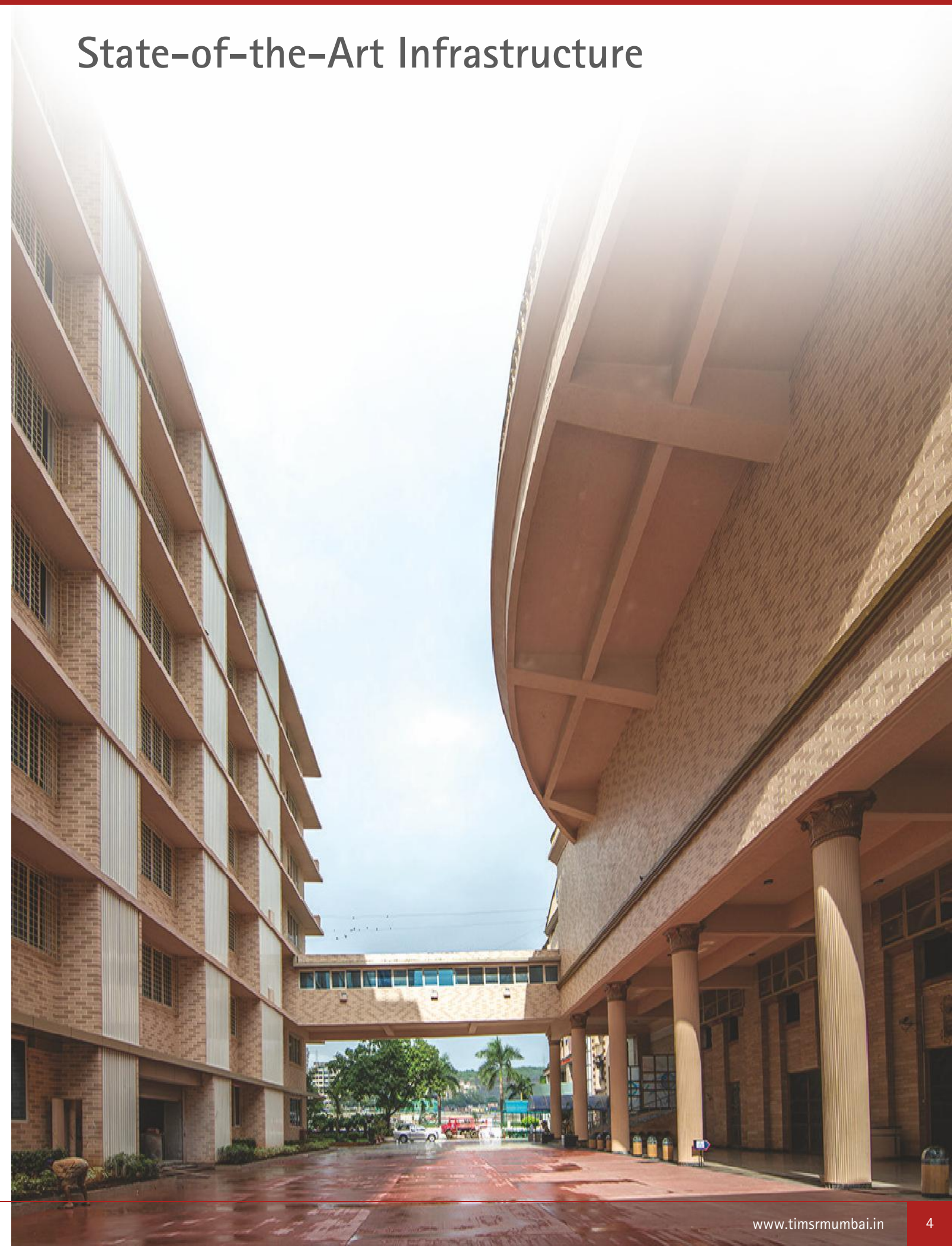

Classrooms

The classrooms are well equipped with all modern conveniences. They are fully air-conditioned and have all necessary teaching aids like LCD and Internet facility with LAN supported system for practical teaching. The classroom has an Interactive Projector that offers multi-user capability that helps to interact with the computer to control, annotate and draw through interactive stylus or fingers.



Learning Resource Center (Library)

Learning resource center (LRC) is well stocked with latest editions of text books, journals, E-books, reference books, encyclopedia, periodicals, educational CDs, audio and video CDs spanning the entire spectrum of management subjects. The LRC provides a reference book section along with OPAC facilities to the students which enable online access to the catalogue with e-resources like ProQuest, J-Gate, ACE and Dion Insight.



Auditorium

The state-of-the-art 583-seater auditorium is equipped with modern lighting and sound system. The sound proof auditorium is the ideal place to organize various corporate events, institute level activities and inter-institute festivals and seminars for the students. It also provides an excellent venue for conducting guest lectures by eminent personalities.



Computer Laboratory

The institute has excellent computing and hardware infrastructure and laboratories. Placement & Student Development Cell

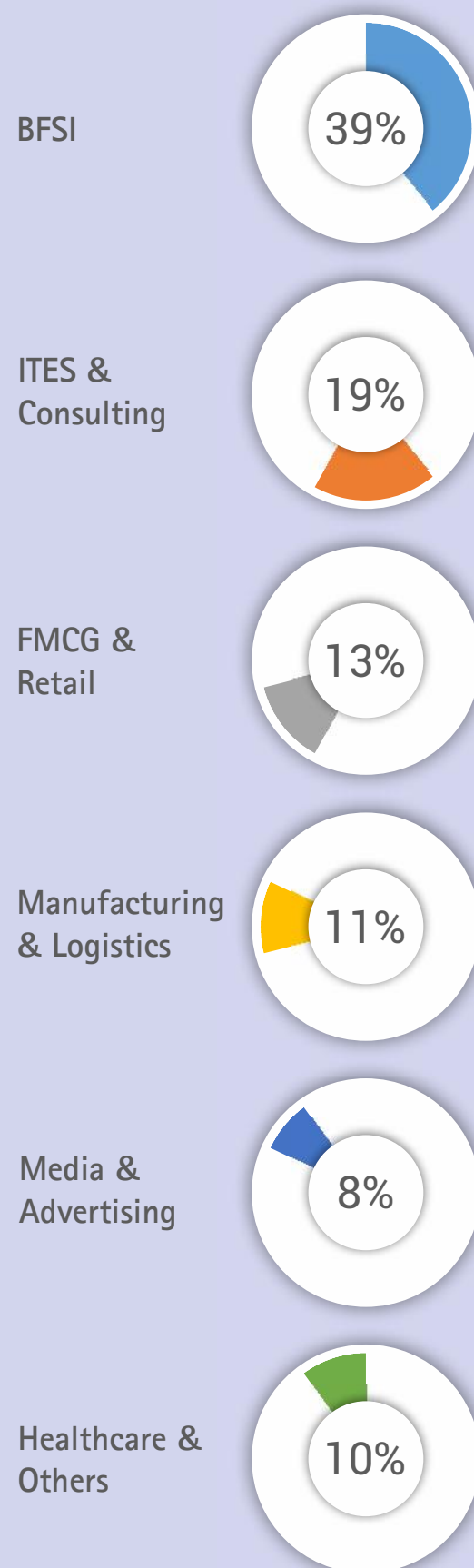

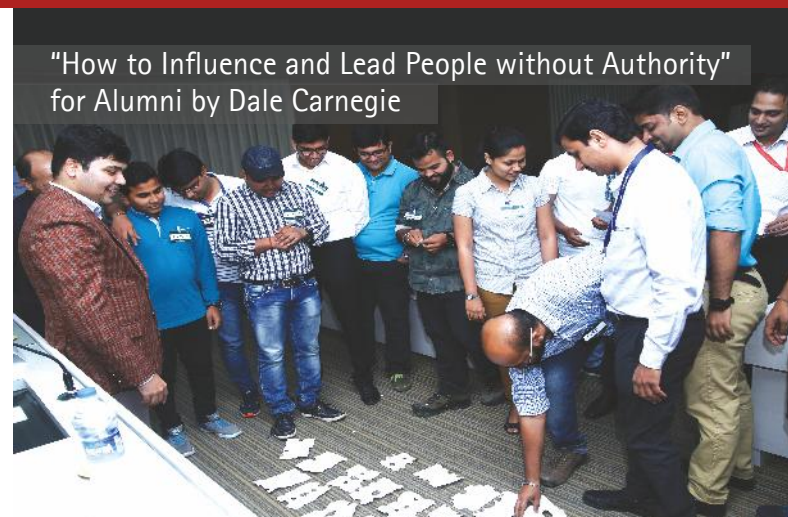
